- -Surface, either 1 Dark UART P400 4 ply Board 12x16 OR 1 Sennelier La Carte Pastel paper 19.5"x25.5" (cut downsize for travel 12x16) Charcoal or if not in stock Dark Gray
- -Masking Tape
- -wet Wipes or rag/cloth
- -Easel is optional or can work flat
- -Drop Cloth
